The Firm, on behalf of our client Cartier International A.G., prevailed in an opposition proceeding before the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board of the United States Patent and Trademark Office. The Board held that confusion was likely, finding that Cartier's TRINITY mark was strong and that jewelry and handbags were related.
