The examiner had previously refused the mark as merely descriptive and denied registration. Such reversals are generally rare, as the TTAB affirmance rate for descriptiveness rejections is over 80%. *In re Stella McCartney Ltd.*, App. Ser. No. 87410072 (T.T.A.B. Mar. 29, 2019).
